Thank you for joining us as we pray for, and with, our community. Please use this as a guide to say these prayers aloud or silently as you walk around the Commons.

STOP 1: VILLAGE HALL

Pray for our local mayors, trustees, and Governor

“We are reminded today, Lord, that You are a good, good Father. With this in mind, we pray for and lift up our local leadership for your blessing and gracious intervention. Thank you that Mayor Baldermann of New Lenox and Governor Pritzker of Illinois, as well as the other mayors and trustees in the surrounding area, serve the people of this town and state. I pray that they would serve with renewed vigor to address the needs of our communities.”

STOP 2: LIBRARY

Pray for our schools

“Lord, who promises to be with us always, we pray that you will be with the students, teachers, and administrators who are beginning school this week. We lift up our schools: Cherry Hill, Spencer Trail, Spencer Pointe, Spencer Crossing, Tyler, Bentley, Nelson Prairie, Nelson Ridge, Haines, Oakview, Liberty, Martino and Haven Administration Center. STOP 3: AMERICAN FLAG
